

## **Scheduling Directions for Grade 11 – There are three parts:**

- Please fill out in pencil and BE NEAT.
- Review your transcript and make sure you list any MMC requirements you have not satisfied and list them under electives on your request sheet.
- **PART A:** Circle your selection for English, math, science and social studies.
- **You will need a recommendation for English, math, science and any AP course selections.**
- **Remember, if you request a two semester class (for example: Woods IA and Woods IB) as an elective or alternate, you must use two boxes. One for EACH semester.**
- **PART B:** All students will take Strategies for Success, unless otherwise counselor approved. If you have approval, write your elective choices in boxes 9-12. Otherwise, only write in electives in boxes 11 & 12. If you still need world language, PE, or Health, make sure to write it under electives.
- **PART C:** Alternates are classes that you will take if you do not get your elective choices. Write in 6 alternate choices.
- Advanced Placement Agreement. First, you must have a recommendation from your teacher in order to sign up. Second, you and a parent must sign the agreement.
- You may also pick a 7<sup>th</sup> option if you have scheduled at least 5 cores and want to fit another in your schedule to work ahead. A parent signature is required.
- **\*AP and dual enrollment coursework will be graded on a 5.0 scale.**
- **\*\*Make sure your parents sign your sheet AT THE BOTTOM**
- **\*\*Course requests are due February 11 to your English teacher**
